820. **Confirmation of Minutes:**
The minutes of meeting held on 18 June 2025 were **RESOLVED** as a correct record of the proceedings thereat. Cllr Hardcastle abstained due to not attending the meeting.

821. **Clerk's Report:**

- AGAR documents were submitted to external auditor PKF Littlejohn on 19 June 2025, they have acknowledged receipt.
- I am waiting for costs from John E Wright regarding vinyl's in the bus stops.
- I have received an email from a resident raising her concerns over the continued dangerous parking on Grange Road, this was also sent to the Police, I have not had any update on this.
- I have received an email (too late to go on Agenda) from Senior Engineer in Traffic Management from ERYC offering to meet with the Council to discuss the on-going problems regarding pedestrian safety, parking, and traffic management in the village. Date to be confirmed.
- Thorngumbald Pre-School have been awarded a grant from Yorkshire Energy park to have bi-folding doors fitted in the Main Hall, as agreed at the meeting held on 22 January 2025. These will be fitted during the summer break.
- This year's scarecrow trail will be held on the weekend of 23 and 24 August 2025.
- The Journal is being put together and a draft copy will be emailed out next week, ready to print 5 August for Delivery 7 August.

- Following lengthy discussions the resolution to start the process of registering Plumtree Road Playing Field with Land Registry was deferred until September meeting. It was **RESOLVED** that an article be included in the Parish Journal giving background information, what the options are and ask for Parishioners feedback by no later than 9 September 2025, a decision at the September meeting will then be agreed.
- The Sibling Squad Lifestyle Group are campaigning to improve road safety at the Zebra Crossing on Main Road (Community Institute), they have produced a poster that will be included in the Parish Journal and have also displayed around the village. It was **RESOLVED** to support their campaign. They are also litter picking around the village, it was **RESOLVED** to supply litter pickers and refuse bags.

- Thorngumbald Pre-School request permission to enable them to lay artificial grass to the floor of the outdoor classroom - **RESOLVED**
