862. **Confirmation of Minutes:**

The minutes of meeting held on 18 March 2026 were **RESOLVED** as a correct record of the proceedings thereat

863. **Clerk's Report:**

- Report on potholes to ERYC Damson Road/ Plumtree Road. Work has been carried out
- Good Councillor training has been booked for Cllrs Auker, Brown and McKeown 9, 16 & 23 June
- The Bus shelter at Bridge Bungalows will be installed week commencing 27 April 2026
- The tree work at the allotments has been carried out, leaving chippings and logs for the allotment holders to use
- The report to ERYC has led to the path between Bridge Bungalows and Ryehill being edged which has made the path wider for pedestrians
- The Annual Parish meeting was held on 11 April, thank you to the Cllrs who attended. 1 member of the public attended
- The Vat return has been submitted to HMRC
- Clerk has successfully completed the Rialtas accounts year end close via teams.
- Clerk has emailed Streetscape to enquire about grants for removing the half pipe and replacing it with play equipment suitable for older children. Waiting for quotes and more information.
- Clerk had a report about the Ash tree hanging over the adjoining property to the village hall, its dropping branches requiring the residents to move their caravan to avoid damage. The tree surgeon will monitor the tree as it starts to leaf to determine what is best course of action
- Clerk has contacted sustainable development @ ERYC to make enquiries the planting of trees in our Parish. Awaiting a reply with more information

- The allotment invoices have been sent for 2026-2027, there has been an error with the transfer of some data to a new system in place, the error has been rectified and amended invoices have been sent out. Mixed feedback has been received to the increase of fees.
- Clerk has contacted the ERYC library service to make enquiries to the possibility of funding to make repairs to the car park at the amenity area
- A new heavy duty lawn mower was purchased to replace the old mower which sadly fell apart, plus the council has received the kind donation of a second smaller mower from Cllrs Auker & Brown
